
### Replica of Time Capsule (2004)

This is a miniature of the HGP time capsule which was sealed on 19th November 2004. in conjunction with our 5th Prize-Giving Ceremony. The guest of honour was Miss Teo Lian Geok, Superintendent for North 3 Cluster. In 2004, the students of Hougang Primary School decided that the best location to install the time capsule was at the school's porch since it is in view of everyone entering the school. The time capsule was sealed to mark the school's 5th Anniversary and to preserve a slice of the school's history. Some of the items in the time capsule include students' work, paraphernalia and photographs of the old school compound.





Dawn 1 Storybook (2004)



A compilation of compositions by HGP students which was published in November 2004. It consists of stories written by students in English and the official Mother Tongue Languages (Chinese, Malay and Tamil). The publication is the school's first step towards building the confidence and hopes of budding writers who have the potential of becoming competent and creative writers of the future.

This songbook was introduced in 2003 and is kept in the music room. They are still in use today. It aims to expose HGP students to a variety of songs such as National Day Songs, Children's Day Songs and Campfire songs.

### Official School Opening Ceremony Booklet (2002)

The school was declared open at the Official School Opening Ceremony by the guest of honour, RADM(NS) Teo Chee Hean, Minister for Education and Second Minister for Defence on 19 July 2002. The ceremony was webcast live on the Internet and over 7000 people logged on to watch the event live.





### Collection of 7 - Core Value Items (2002 - 2016)

The 7 core values of HGP, or more popularly known as 7-Ups, was implemented from 2002 to 2015. The 7 values were Responsibility, Integrity, Compassion, Courage, Loyalty, Perseverance and Wisdom. Each core value was tagged to an animal mascot and a level, with the exception of Primary 6 pupils who had two core values tagged to its level. The animal mascots were designed by Mr Colin Chia, one of the teachers in HGP. A collection of these 7 values could also be presented as a token of appreciation to external organisations and HGP partners. The 7-Ups for HGPians was replaced, with the current 4 core values (Care, Integrity, Resilience and Responsibility), in 2016.



### X-Cell Zone File (2002)





The X-Cell Zone File was presented as a door gift to guests during the official opening of the X-Cell Zone on 18 April 2002. A young paper bark tree was planted by Miss Teo Lian Geok, Superintendent of N3 Cluster Schools, to mark the official opening. The paper bark tree is now over 10 metres tall.
